4. Financial Update & Budget Discussion: (Trudi Trask)

-Trudi presented and reviewed financial transactions & balances for the months of June, July and August and was as the 2021/2022 operating budget. -2021-2022 Actual

Revenues: \$142,307.51; Expenses: \$173,528.76

- -We made \$65,000 in fundraising in 2021/2022 school year
- -Family Fun Night: we made \$15,600.00
- -We will present & vote on our operating budget in November
- -Next meeting we will be making changes to our signing authority
- -Motion to accept financials as presented: Nicole Goodis
- -Second: Renee Woolley
- -Motion has passed.

5. Parent concern about bathroom conditions. (Jessica Petrie)

- -Messy bathrooms, so stalls were unusable. Also a lock in one of the girls bathrooms doesn't work properly. What is the policy for cleaning, etc.
- -MJ answered: we don't have a custodian during the day. So any issues are reported to teacher & then the office, so then staff will go to clean.
- -A concern about the washrooms was echoed by other parents.
- -There are 2 other washrooms that children can use when one is in use, or out of order. A request to communicate this information to students was made.
